This will occur the same day as the last T-34 Race. **(7)** George Santikian mentioned that so far, there's been no activity on the Guys property; however, emphasized that perhaps, we should start a committee to explore finding a new site in the event some real offer is made that might dislocate us. **(8)** Carl inquired and it was confirmed that at this point, the 2005 Christmas banquet will be on Friday, 12/16/05. **(9)** George mentioned that he learned that club member Feron Green has since moved to Georgia.
